### Setting up your stream

- Choose the platform you want to stream on. We recommend using Twitch, but you can also use YouTube or Facebook. **Read Tiltify's handy guide on how to use Twitch.**
- 2 Set up your fundraising page via Tiltify. From Wednesday 1 November at 5pm you will be able to set up your page, using this <u>unique link</u>. On 1 December at 5pm you will need to publish your page. <u>Use Tiltify's handy guide to help you get started.</u>
- If you want to get creative, use a streaming platform such as Streamlabs, OBS, or Golightstream. This will enable you to create pop-up messages, change colours, design your own overlays, and make fun GIFS connected with donations amounts.
- Check out our <u>Streaming Toolkit</u> for overlays, videos, and graphics to help with your stream. For more information about using overlays with Tiltify, <u>check out their guide.</u>
- 5 Once you've set up your stream and Tiltify page, you are ready to start fundraising! Promote your stream and let everyone know what you are doing, where, and when! Share on your social media channels and join the new Jingle Jam community discord server.
- 6 Engage your audience through Tiltify. You can offer them donation perks and incentives to help boost your fundraising and make your stream fun.

#### Ideas for donation perks include:

- the donor gets a shout-out if they donate £10
- 💠 the donor gets the Jingle Jam collection for a donation of £35
- the donor chooses the next game or song if they donate £50

### You can also add incentives for when you reach a certain percentage of your goal. Ideas for incentives include:

- 💠 eat a spoon of mustard
- + sing the Wallace & Gromit theme tune
- 🛉 do 20 stars jumps
- 🛉 change into fancy dress
- 🛉 head shave for reaching your target
